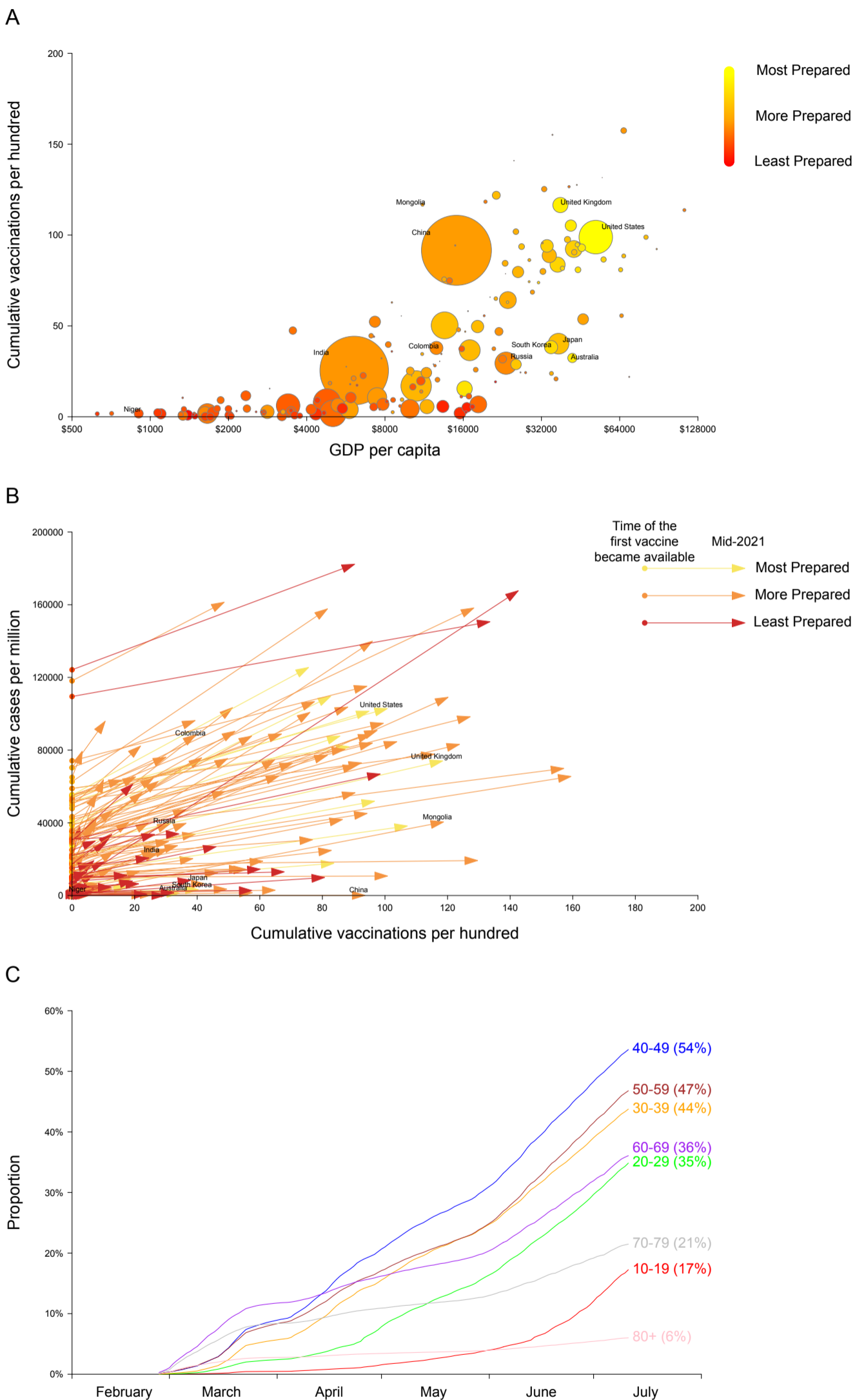
Transitioning from covid-19 elimination to sustainable endemicity in East Asia

The colour indicates 2019 Global Health Security Index of each country, which was classified as Most Prepared (66.7-100), More Prepared (33.4-66.6) and Least Prepared (0-33.3).

Panel B. Total confirmed COVID-19 cases per million people and total COVID-19 vaccinations per hundred people. The colour indicates 2019 Global Health Security Index of each country, which was classified as Most Prepared (66.7-100), More Prepared (33.4-66.6) and Least Prepared (0-33.3).

Panel C. Cumulative proportion of 1st dose of COVID-19 vaccine per age group in Hong Kong as of 11 July.

There are 195 countries on the list of GHS index, but the total vaccinations and total cases data are only available for 178 of them. Among them, the number of countries in each continent are 44 (Asia), 50 (Africa), 44 (Europe), 21 (North America), 12 (South America) and 7 (Oceania) respectively. And some countries were labelled in the figure, including 5/44 (Asia), 1/50 (Africa), 2/44 (Europe), 1/21 (North America), 1/12 (South America) and 1/7 (Oceania).
